Minutes

Treasurer Report: Laurie said that the Town Accountant agreed to take the payroll out of the state grant and not the town account. Payroll and expenditures will be placed in the COA's mailbox.

Winter Usage: The Selectboard agreed to allow the seniors to use the Senior Center throughout the winter. \$4,000 was quoted as a reasonable price for fuel for the season. Use will be monitored. There was a discussion on how to insulate the building and the costs associated. The Senior Center building will be included on the application for the Green Community Grants.
