

Results of the Special Town Meeting

September 30, 2009

Joseph Kearns , the moderator, opened the Special Town Meeting by reading the warrant then led the assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance. There were 34 people in attendance. The meeting opened at 7:30 P.M.

Article 1. A motion was made and seconded to see if the Town will vote to borrow up to \$30,000.00 for up to 5 years to purchase a used 4x4 truck which would replace a 1978 truck, or take any other action related thereto. Larry Pease, Selectman, read the bid for the truck and Skip Savery, the road boss, gave a short history of the old truck. He said that the old truck would be taken out of service but he would keep the wing. Plow frame, the hoses, and the plow.. also some axles and the front end. The Moderator said that we would need a 2/3 vote. Question was asked how much money was in the Stabilization Account \$200,000.00. As we had enough people for the 2/3 vote, the vote was taken. It was an unanimous vote and the Article passed.

Article 4. Under this Article, Joe Kearns announced that there would be a hazardous Waste Collection at the Russell Conwell School in Worthington on Saturday. Discussion also arose about the building at the Transfer Station. Many suggestions came forward and Joe said they would be taken under advisement. Motion made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
