**GREETINGS:** In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs, to meet in the Middlefield Town Hall in said Middlefield on Monday the twentieth day of June next, at 8:00 in the evening then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

**ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$15,276.47 from Gateway Regional School account to snow removal account; or take any other action relative thereto:

**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$50,000 from Free Cash to offset the tax levy for FY 2012; or take any other action relative thereto:
