## Special Town meeting Warrant

Hampshire, ss:

To either of the Constables of the Town of Middlefield in the County of Hampshire

**Greetings:** In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs, to meet in the Town Hall in said Middlefield on the twenty-second (22) day of June at 7:00pm then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

**ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$5,000 from Free Cash to the Town Counsel Account or take any action relative thereto;

**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$5,000 from Free Cash to the Vocational Education Account or take any action relative thereto;

**ARTICLE 3.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer from Free Cash \$ 8,000 to the Fuels Account;

**ARTICLE 4.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer \$5,000 from Free Cash to the Maintenance of Public Buildings Account;

**ARTICLE 5.** To see if the Town will Vote to transfer \$23,280.82 from Free Cash to the Snow Removal Account;

**ARTICLE 6.** To transact any other business to come before said meeting.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies of same in the Middlefield Post Office, on the bulletin board at the Town Hall, a designated place in the Bancroft section of the Town and a designated place in Smith Hollow, at least fourteen (14) days before time of holding said meeting. Hereof, fail not and make due return of this warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meetings as aforesaid.


