

4.5 SIGNS

4.5.1 General

- a. No sign shall
 - 1. be blinking
 - 2. have any moving parts
 - 3. be of a noise making variety
 - 4. be illuminated by a spotlight located so as to cast a beam into the eyes of oncoming motorists
 - 5. extend or protrude over public property
 - 6. be erected that is less than ten (10) feet from a traveled way
- b. Political signs not to exceed six (6) square feet in area shall be permitted by right. Election signs must be removed within 14 days of election results
- c. Two similar signs, back to back, so as to face opposite directions, shall be considered one sign

4.5.2 Residential Signs

One sign may be erected at each place of residence, with an area not in excess of 4 square feet.

4.5.3 Accessory Uses

Signs for Accessory Uses advertising the type of business, occupation or trade carried on at the premises or with a structure thereon or the principal product or service sold thereat are subject to the following requirements:

- a. Display of signs is limited to one sign pertaining to a permitted use
- b. The total area of a sign shall not be more than six (6) square feet

4.5.4 Business and Industrial Signs

- c. One sign may be erected at each place of business or industry, with an area not in excess of 12 square feet, advertising the type of business, occupation or trade carried on at the premises or with a structure thereon or the principal product or service sold thereat
