

Town Center Committee
June 5, 2014 Minutes

The meeting came to order at 7:05. Committee members present were Victor Artioli, Howard Knickerbocker, Alan Vint, Mitch Feldmesser, Jay Swift, Judy Hoag, Dale Hoag and Maureen Sullivan. Joining the committee at the table were Cathy Roth and Jack Cobb representing the concerns of the Middlefield Heritage Society.

The minutes of the May 20th meeting were read and amended. A motion to accept the minutes as amended was made and seconded. All voted in favor to accept the amended minutes.

Mr. Swift announced that the PVPC Brownfield program was not funded for the coming year. Andrew Loew of the PVPC encouraged Mr. Swift to stay in contact with him about the potential for funding using the current fiscal year's unexpended funds.

Mr. Vint addressed an email from Mr. Doust of the DEP concerning demolition requirements for brownfield structures. He also distributed copies of a memo from Caprice Shaw re the incident mentioned by Mr. Dinicola at the February 27, 2014 Town Center Committee meeting.

Ms. Hoag updated the committee on her attempts to obtain information from Elizabeth Rairigh of the PVPC re notification for demolition of structures in a historic district.

Mr. Swift gave a recap of the committee's work for Ms. Roth and Mr. Cobb.

A discussion on the matter of the old general store building's viability for reuse and/or relocation ensued. There was widespread agreement that preservation of the structure at a new location would be the most advantageous outcome. Ms. Roth volunteered to call some building relocation companies.

Mr. Swift will invite Andre Loew to the next meeting.

The next meeting was scheduled for Thursday June 19th at 7pm.

A motion to adjourn was made and seconded at 8:51. All voted in favor of adjournment.
