**Minutes:** Motions were made and seconded to approve August 8 minutes as written. Motion passed unanimously.

**Mail:**

- The Commission received a notice of a tax lien complaint by Land Court concerning a parcel of land on Skyline Trail. Mitch will contact Tax Attorney Ronald J. Berenson to find out what the process is. The notice was copied and filed.
- Notice of changes in the forestry cutting practices regulations was received. Old version: Clearing land for the purpose of changing land use such as creating a house lot, subdivisions, mining gravel or any activity requiring town or city permits, when supported by the issuance of the necessary permits prior to the start of cutting. New Permit: (when supported by the issuance of the necessary permits prior to the start of cutting) has been removed.
  - If someone comes in regarding part of a parcel that they are logging, and states that they are using two acres for a house lot, the Commission should inform the State Forestry that they are changing the use of part of the parcel.

**Guard Rail Posts:**

- Skip Savery requested signatures to change guard rail posts on Chester Rd within 100 ft of the water. Chapter 90 funds will be used to pay for it. The request was granted and the Commission signed the paperwork.
